Consumer Compliance

- ✓ Batteries - No charge from 1st January 2010
- ✓ Make sure you take your batteries to your nearest collection point.
- ✓ Visit www.BatteryBack.org to find your nearest collection point and all the other information you need to know



Retailer Compliance

- ✓ Obligated to collect consumer's waste batteries for FREE from the 1st February 2010
- ✓ Sell more batteries by offering in store collection
- ✓ Be ahead of your competitors
- ✓ No cost, guaranteed

15th October 2009

Don't get a shock!
If you place batteries on the UK market in 2009 then you now need to register as a battery producer.

Expected weight placed on UK market in 2009	EA Fees	Scheme Fees	Compliance cost per battery placed on market
Less than 1 Tonne	£30	-	-
1-5 Tonnes	£680	£560	1 penny
Over 5 Tonnes	£680	£2,000	1 penny
